NPRA's Safety Statistics and Awards Program, designed to promote the excellent safety records the contractors have achieved, is part of a comprehensive safety program developed by NPRA's Fire and Accident Prevention Committee. The Safety Awards are based on records kept for employees in accordance with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration's (OSHA) record keeping requirements. Contractor members must be nominated by a member company to be eligible for an award.

Additionally, the Greater New Orleans Industrial Educational Council (GNOIEC) recently honored Brand with six safety awards. Brand-New Orleans earned the awards for achieving an injury-free workplace in 2004, working in the following facilities with more than 500,000 combined labor hours:
